

Three photos of buildings in Milford NY. At the postcard

left is an image of the New York Store, South Main Street. 3 story building with peaked roof. Four windows on each of the upper stories. New York Store painted between the two rows. Large covered porch on the first floor. Several people stand on the porch. In front of the store sits a wagon hitched to horses. To the left can be seen a set of stairs. The building also extends farther to the right out of the frame. on the upper right is an image of the Wilber Block, East Main Street Milford NY. A two story building. 6 windows on the top floor with Wilber Block painted above them. Bottom floor has large showroom windows with awning /curtians atop. eight people stand on the porch of the building. A three wheeled bicycle sits in front of the store with 2 people on it. Bottom right image shows the Correll Market, Bank, and store of G.W. Whitney. The two buildings sit at the corner of North and West Main Streets. The corner house has a tee in front directly at the corner, and another up the west side. There are 4 windows on the second floor and several on the first. The door of this building is at the corner. a man stands in front of it. Three others lean against the main street side of the building. The second building is also two stories. The top story has 5 windows. The bottom story has a storefront with showroom windows, there are three people standing on the porch in front of the right windows.
