Description

In the image is a Pioneer Threshing Machine manufactured by Pioneer Threshing Company located in Shortsville, Ontario County, New York. The tractor is an Oliver Standard 80 manufactured between 1937 and 1948. The scene shows the threshing machine in use including one person putting grain into the machine from a pile on a wagon, another person bagging the grain to the right, and the straw coming out of the wind stacker to the back of the machine. A truck is also to the right side of the scene with another person behind the vehicle.
