Vintage black and white photograph mounted on board. 32 women suffragists (and one infant) are seated in front of the historic Carnegie library in Binghamton, NY. Several women wear white, an international symbol of woman's voting rights, and many proudly display badges and ribbons from membership in suffrage groups and their activity as delegates in regional or national conventions. New York state had one of the most active communities of women suffrage advocates, and Binghamton hosted the 1913 New York State Woman Suffrage Association Convention.
