### Description

A large produce display created by the New York State Dept of Agriculture and Markets was presumably on view at the New York State Fair. Through signage and display of excellent produce varieties, the NYS Dept. of Agriculture discusses that NEW YORK MUST GRADE TO MEET COMPETITION. Other signs say: NEW YORK PRODUCTS LIKE THESE/MUST COMPETE WITH PRODUCTS LIKE THESE/BUT IT CAN BE DONE. Another sign off to the (right) side says, MODERN PUBLIC MARKETS/OUR GREATEST NEED. In the display are bagged, crated and boxed potatoes, celery, summer squash, cabbage, onions, apples and tomatoes. Several farms and producers are represented through the packaging used for the display.
