Description

A beekeeper stands in a trampled down area of a field in a beekeeper's veil, long shirt, suspenders, long pants and boots. He does not wear gloves or other protective gear. On either side him are bee hives of different styles. The

one on the left is a Cowen style hive, one-tiered with a sloped top. The one on the right is a Cheshire style hive, two-tiered with a flat top. Trees are behind the beekeeper and a fence is on his left. The beekeeper likely lived in Tioga County, New York.
