Fifteen men pose in front of a wheel of cheese that weighs 10,100 pounds. The cheese wheel is ready to load to be

transported. These creations were usually displayed at the New York State Fair, other fairs or expositions around this time. The cheese is in front of a building, likely a creamery in Lowville or the local area. Some of the men are identified on the back of the print. First from left is Harold J. Richardson. Fourth from left is Stanley Miller, then Harvey Farrington, then Nick Woolschlager and Cal Salsburg(?). Tenth from left is Raymond Richardson.
