Description

A group of young men, possibly farmworkers, or family members of farmworkers, gather in a kitchen-like space. This space may be a part of the Dixie Belle Inn, a controversial housing complex for farmworkers on the North Fork of Long Island. A 1968 documentary, "What Harvest for the Reaper," recorded poor living conditions, price gouging, and farmworker debt in this area, and spoke to farmworkers who lived in the Dixie Belle Inn.
