Description

Five farmers are working in a barn. Three are Caucasian and two are African American. One African American is wearing a dark button up shirt tucked into a pair of light pants with a belt. He has a watch on his left arm. The other African American is wearing a light shirt tucked into dark pants with gloves in his back pocket. The three Caucasian workers are focusing on something that the picture doesn't show. One Caucasian worker is wearing a light shirt tucked into a pair of light pants. The other worker is wearing a light shirt tucked into dark pants with a belt. The final worker is wearing a plaid shirt. That is all the picture shows of the final worker. All but one worker are wearing dark baseball caps. One African American farmer is tying a bag of potatoes closed while the other is opening a paper bag. The picture is taken with the African Americans in the foreground and the Caucasians in the background. None of the workers are looking at the camera.
