### Description

Eleven men and two boys stand in front of a large factory building where barrels are made. Most of the coopers wear aprons. Most of the men hold a coopering tool in one

hand. The fifth man from the left holds a draw knife in his hands. The sixth man from the left holds a mallet in his right hand and drawknife in his left hand. On the right, a man sits on top of a pile of split wood. The building is unadorned and a simple structure. A double entry door is in the center of the end of the building and a window flanks each side. To the side of the window on the left an area has been cut out of the exterior wall of the building. Another smaller, square six pane window is beside this. A window is also above the entry door on the second floor. Windows are all along the far end of the side of the building. A chimney is on the left side of the roof.
