## Description

Exterior view of a large three-story barn built of stone. The barn has a low profile gambrel or barrel roof. On the end of the building, on either side are double doors with a

high-rise entry and wooden ramp leading to the doors. Three double hung windows are on the ground floor between these doors. On the second floor are two large windows hung together on each side of the building. A large hay door is in the middle of the barn. A smaller open, possibly with a grate in it, is between the hay door and the double windows. A second hay door is in the center of the third story directly above the other hay door. A double hung window is on either side of the hay door on this floor. On the right side of the building there is a door on the ground and first floor levels. In the center of the side wall, on both ground and first floor levels are a set of single doors flanked by windows. A second set of larger doors are at the far end on this side of the building. In partial view is a small addition or outbuilding at the back end of the barn. The barn is situated at the bottom of a wooded hill that is to the left.
