

Yancey's Sugar Bush. Image shows steam rising from the large evaporator (on right) and from the corner of the small evaporator (on left) in the boiling shed at Yancey's Sugarbush. These evaporators were purchased in the 1920s and are still used today. They are fueled by wood cut from the Sugarbush. The evaporators were bought by Andrew Yancey (second generation owner). An unidentified man can be seen from the back on the right side of the image.
