Yancey's Sugar Bush. Image is of a stack of wood in the woodshed as seen from inside the woodshed of the boiling shed. Since the same evaporators purchased in the 1920s are still being used today, wood is still the source of fuel for boiling the sap down. This wood comes from within Yancey's Sugarbush.
