## Description

Image is of a dog in a sugar bush where two roads or sap lanes meet. The dog has been identified by Haskell and Jane Yancey (current owners) as Joe and Edwin Yancey's dog Poochie. Joe and Edwin were third generation family owners of the Sugarbush. Sap buckets are on the sugar maples in the grove. Two - three stacks of sap buckets, laying on their sides, are on the right side of the image. Snow covers the ground. The paths are identified as those going to the boiling shed from Long Pond Road and Fish Creek Road in Croghan, New York.
