Image is of a sugar house in the snow. This view shows the bridge in which horses draw the sleighs or wagons up to boiling shed to unload sap from the gathering tubs. Also in view are the two smokestacks for the evaporators. Yancey's Sugarbush was founded in 1844, and has been a family owned operation since that time. The boiling shed was rebuilt in 1958 by Joseph and Erwin Yancey (third generation owners).
