Etching of a grotesque (or gargoyle) on Notre Dame, called "le Stryge," with the city of Paris laid out in the background. In the center of the image, balancing le Stryge, is the Tour Saint-Jacques (beyond it is the Basilica de Sacre-coeur); a hot air balloon floats in the sky between the two.
