



## Wedding Dress

### Medium

Cotton muslin, cotton net, cotton lace

### Description

One-piece wedding dress of white cotton. Bodice is made with two long pieces that run over shoulders from front to back, meeting in center of body and forming a V neckline; each has floral lace insertion down inner and outer edge and has five tucks over the shoulders. Neckline is filled in with embroidered net, which itself has a jewel neckline. Elbow-length sleeves with lace insertion above hem. Long skirt with many vertical tucks at waist, and two widely spaced strips of lace insertion above hem.
