Description

Pictured posing in a corn field with bundles of corn are Edward Garretson (on left in the hat), his father (on the tractor) and George Moss (in the background), the hired man. Edward explains that the "stick, that sticks out the side" of the tractor in front of the tire, is a "kind of a bumper that when you drive down the rows, it pushes the corn rows back (from the tractor) so that (the vehicle) does not run over them." The tractor is a Case VAC.
