Description

Two men work in a room in a creamery. On the right is a large, closed drum, possibly for the purposes of sterilization of bottles and equipment or for the pasteurization of milk. A man stands at the end of the drum with his left hand on the end of the equipment. Behind him and against the wall, is a large sink and a Babcock tester on a counter. On the left is a milk tank next to a table (or alternate equipment). Pulley systems are attached to the table. A hose is on the floor through the center of the room. An open door is in the back of the room, to the right of the second man.
