Description

Nineteen men, one small child, and four teams of horses stand and sit at various places in a field around a threshing machine, meant to separate the grain from the

chaff. The two men at the center front are sitting on the water wagon, which is connected, by hoses, to the steam traction engine. A belt travels from the engine to the thresher, which is to the right of the men pitching straw. Farthest right is another wagon, around which several men are gathered. Handwritten on the back is "Robert Dvig."
