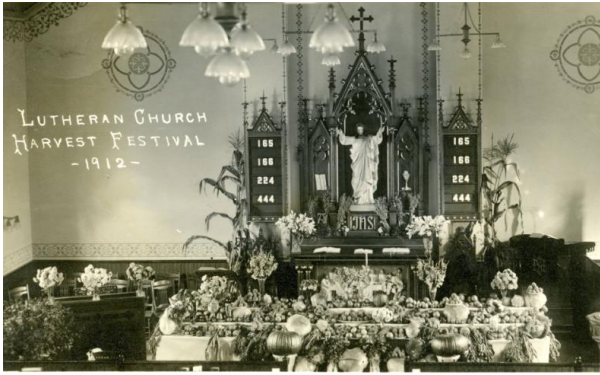

Description

Pictured is the Lutheran Church prepared for the Harvest

Festival. Below the altar is seen a variety of fruits, vegetables, and flowers. The altar is decorated with symmetrical arrangements of wheat bunches and lilies, with three books, likely Bibles, between the flowers. Cornstalks are placed on either side of the altar, while the tables in front are covered with peaches, apples, gourds, squash, potatoes, cabbages, pumpkins, kale, cauliflower, carnations, and gladiolus. At the left of the photograph is an upright piano, on which are placed additional bouquets of carnations.
